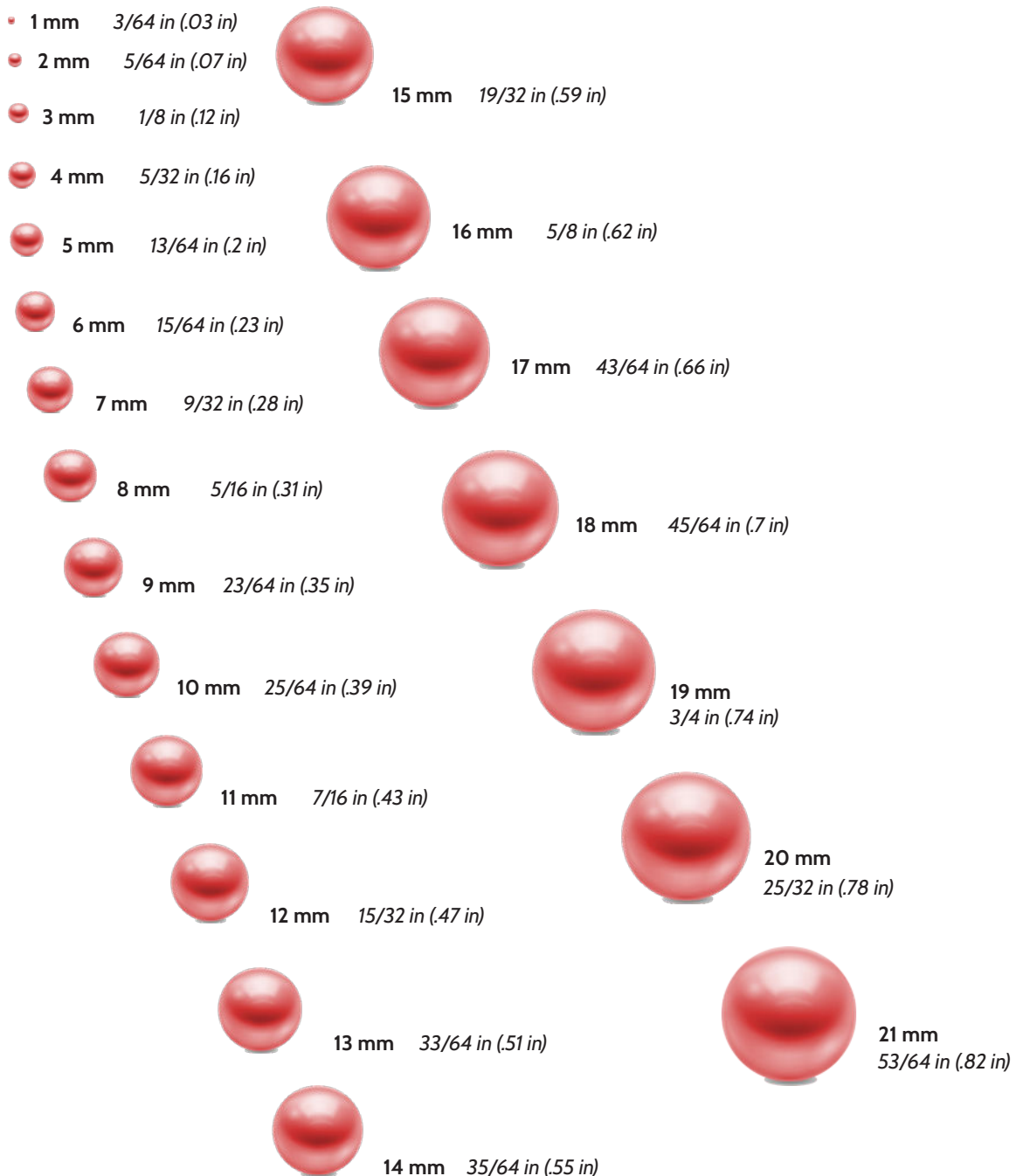


## BEAD SIZE REFERENCES (MM/IMPERIAL/DECIMAL)

Bead size refers to the distance between the two bead holes, regardless of the shape of the bead. The bead size is an essential measurement for beadwork. You will be able to calculate the length of the wire, thread, or cord by considering the bead size of your materials.

Xinar's Complete Guide to Bead Sizes is a printable document that shows standard bead sizes from 1 mm to 30 mm. Due to differences in display resolutions, we highly recommend that you print these sheets at **100% size** using **A4 sheets** (21 cm x 29.7 cm / 8.3 in x 11.7 in) for the best and most accurate results. Be sure to keep our sizing chart handy on your bench for easy reference.
